HOW TO GET TO ROSTOCK

Participants are asked to organise their travels to and from Rostock themselves.

Arrival by Plane

You can arrive via either Berlin Airport (BER, <https://ber.berlin-airport.de/en.html>) or Hamburg Airport (HAM, <https://www.hamburg-airport.de/en>).

I recommend using **Hamburg Airport** due to construction work and route closures on the rail line between Rostock and Berlin, which result in long travel times and multiple train changes on that route.

An exception might be a direct IC train connection from Berlin Airport to Rostock, departing at 11:04 a.m.

If you arrive at Hamburg Airport, you will need to take the S-Bahn to Hamburg Main Station and then transfer to a direct train to Rostock.

Tickets can be purchased on the [DB website](#) or through the DB Navigator app.

How to Get to the Hotel:

The most convenient option is to take tram no. 5 (Mecklenburger Allee) from platform A at Rostock Main Station (“Rostock Hbf”) to “Maßmannstraße” stop. The journey takes about 15 minutes, with trams running every 10 minutes.

From Maßmannstraße, it’s just a 2-minute walk to the hotel.

Tickets cost €3 and can be purchased at the platforms or on the tram using cash or card. Alternatively, tickets are available via the DB Navigator app.

Please also check whether your ticket to Rostock already includes public transportation in Rostock, especially if you travelled via long-distance trains (IC or ICE), as this is often the case then.
